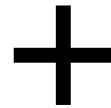

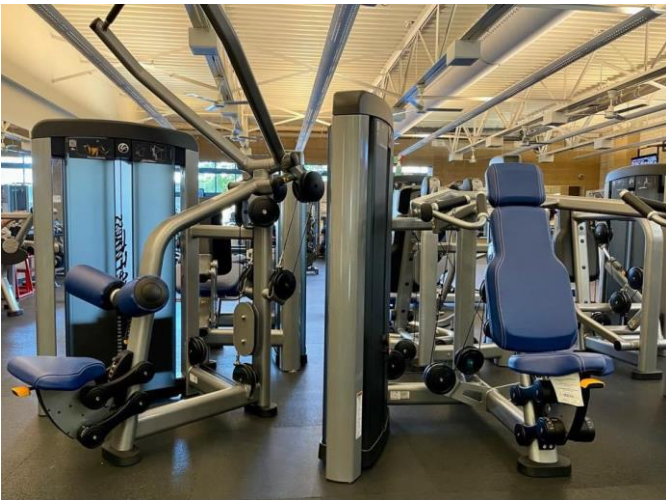

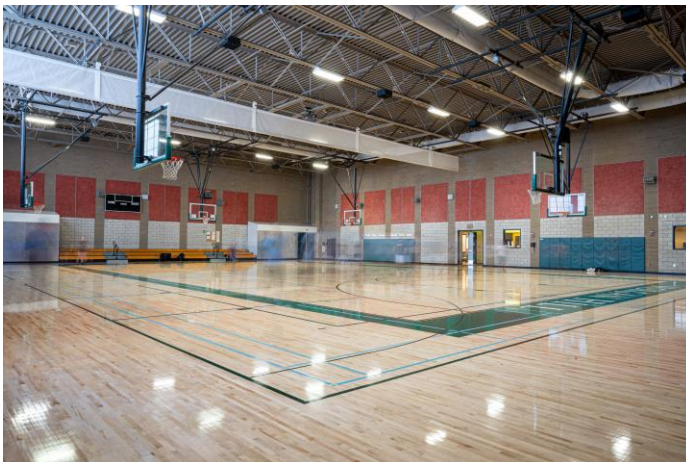

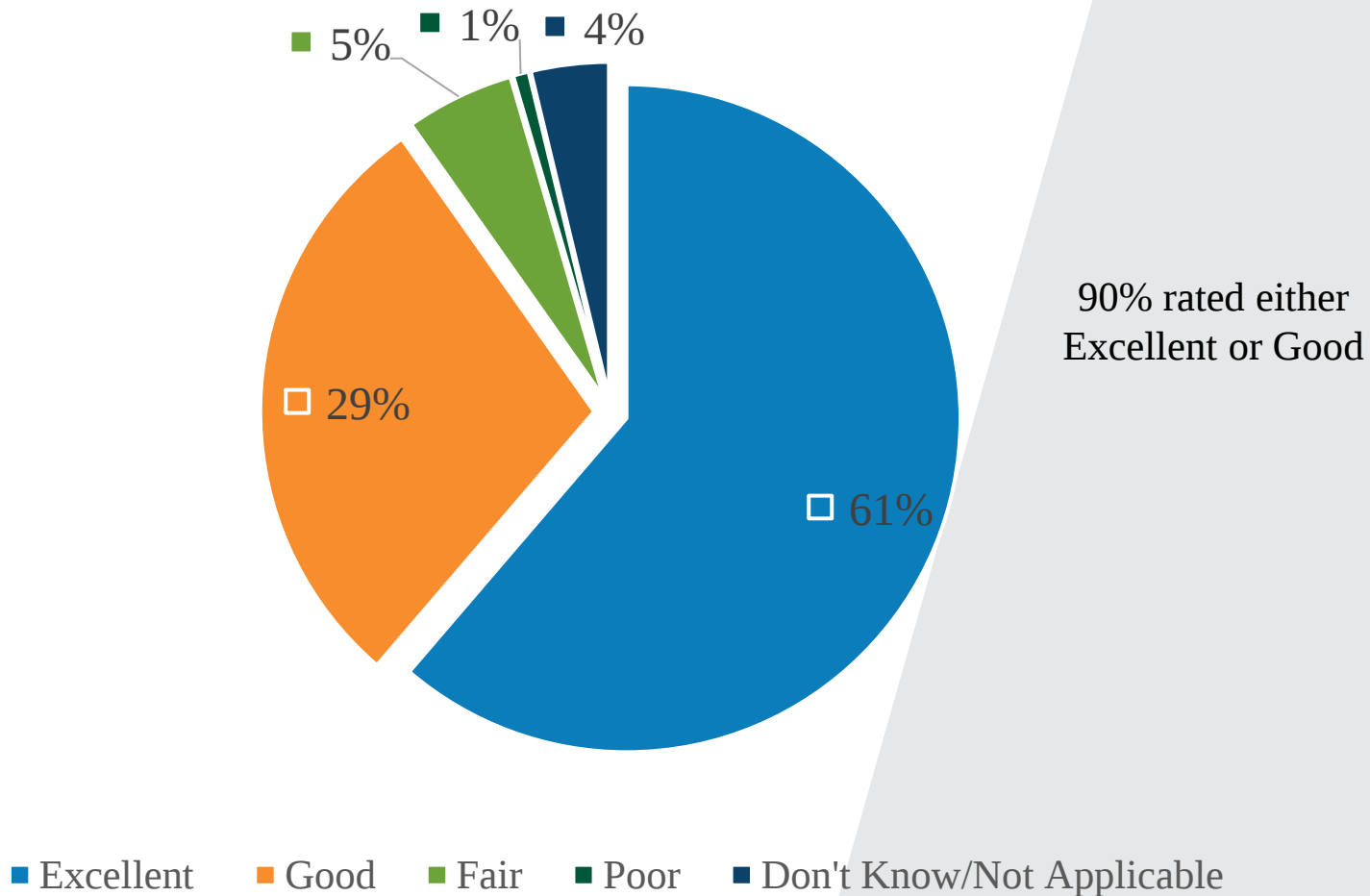

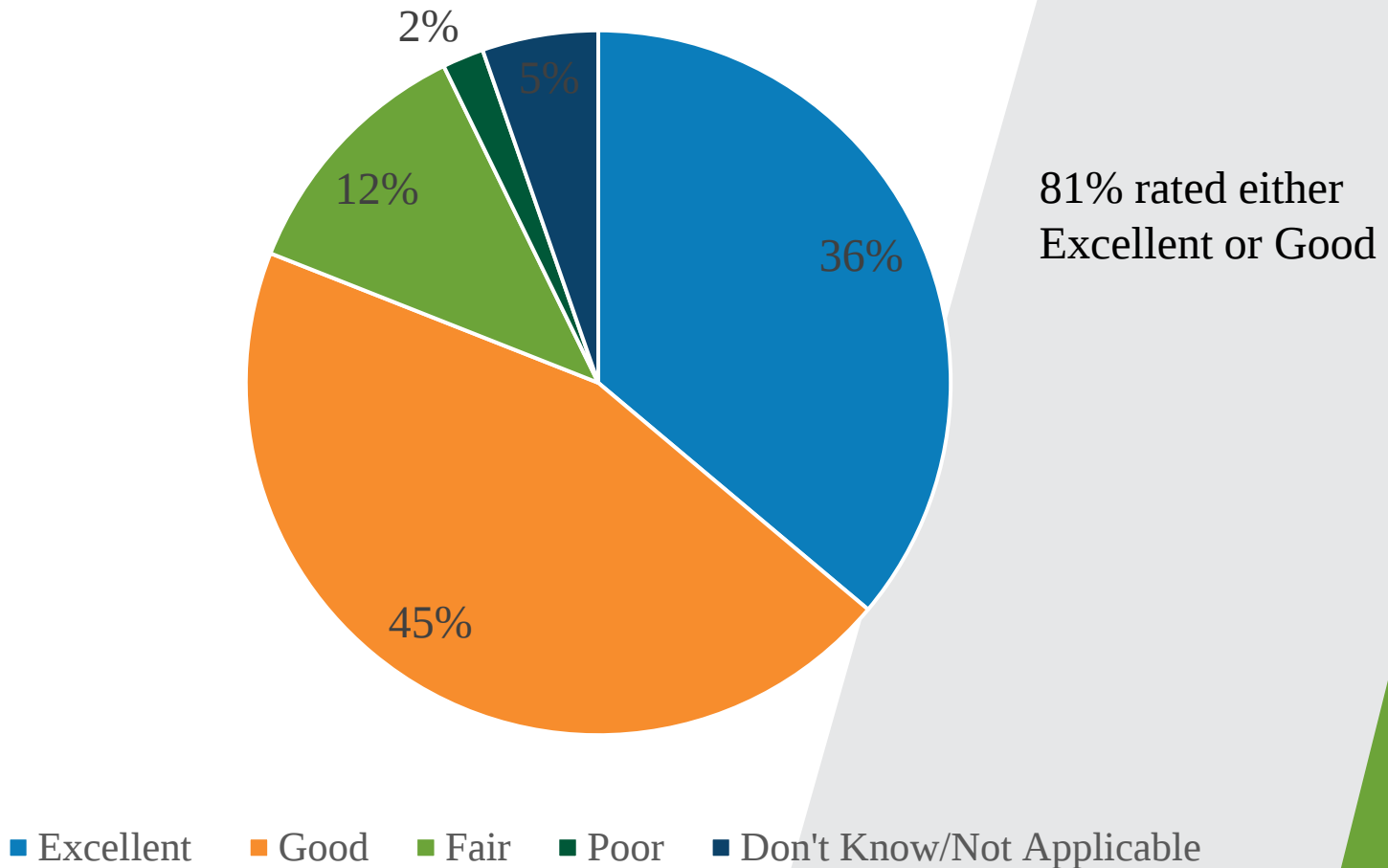

How would you rate the CRC on staff friendliness?



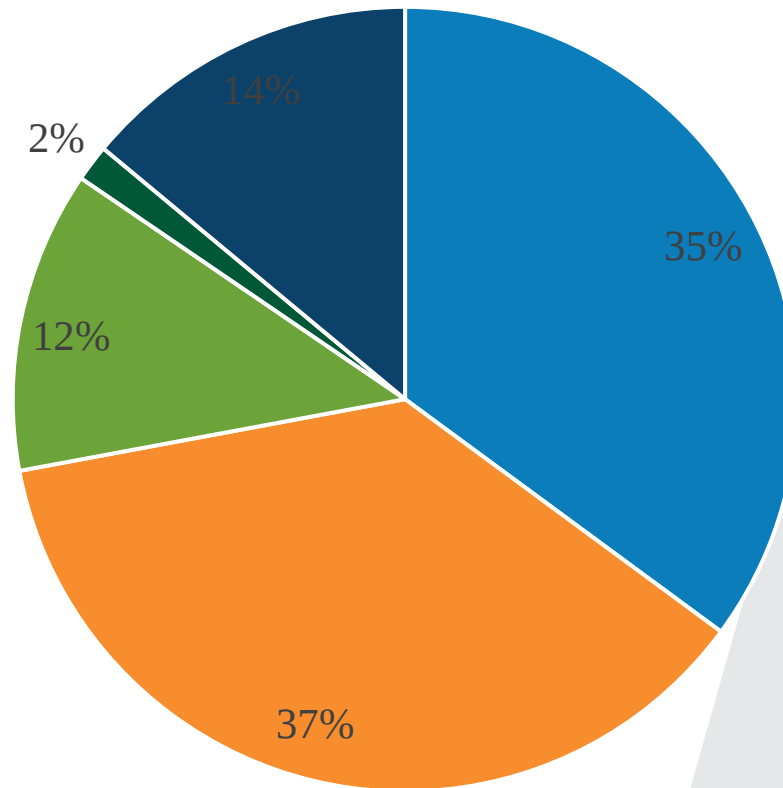
Results

How would you rate the CRC on security and safety of facility?

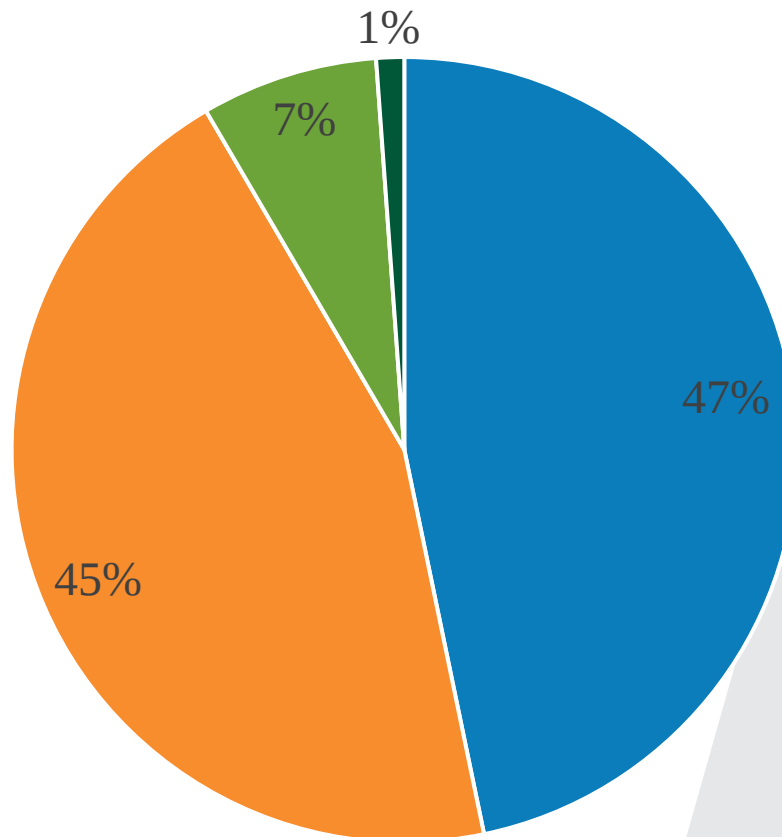
