The time within which judicial review must be sought of the action by the Commission, which acted upon any matter appearing on this agenda is governed by the provisions of Section 1094.6 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.

JOINT CITY OF MORGAN HILL AND MORGAN HILL UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT ITEMS

Brittney Sherman, Economic Development Coordinator, presented on the Elevate Morgan Hill Business Support Program. Healthy Neighborhoods for All

Adam Paszkowski, Chief Planner for the City of Morgan Hill Planning Department presented on Healthy Neighborhoods for All. He addressed Senate Bill 1000 (Environmental Justice), the plan to ensure every neighborhood within Morgan Hill has access to a healthy environment, and the survey to address the associated needs.

Vice President Andrade asked about the location of the apartment buildings being surveyed, and Trustee Altman asked about the language the survey instrument would include.

Superintendent García offered the support of community liaisons for the focus groups, if needed.

Community members Brian Sullivan and Doug Muirhead commented on MOGO and on the work the city is doing with the Healthy Neighborhood Plan.

City Manager Turner shared the temporary funding utilized for MOGO is no longer available.

Police Chief Palsgrove provided an update on school callouts, youth diversion, and upcoming events at local high schools. He announced the date of National Police Week and that they are recruiting for various positions.
