Monterey Corridor Safety and Rehabilitation Project Update

Project Background

One Bay Area Grant 3 (OBAG3)

- Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) created One Bay Area Grant in 2012 to incorporate the region's discretionary transportation funding from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) with Plan Bay Area 2050
- Morgan Hill has received each of the 3 cycles of OBAG
 - Morgan Hill has been awarded \$3.9M for the City's Monterey Corridor Safety and Rehabilitation Project in this most recent cycle of OBAG funding

Monterey Road Collision History

- Monterey Road is on the City's High Injury Network
- Collision Study by TJKM identified primary collision factors along Monterey Road to be unsafe speeding (21%) and improper turning (19%) accounting for 40% of collisions reported between 2015 to 2019

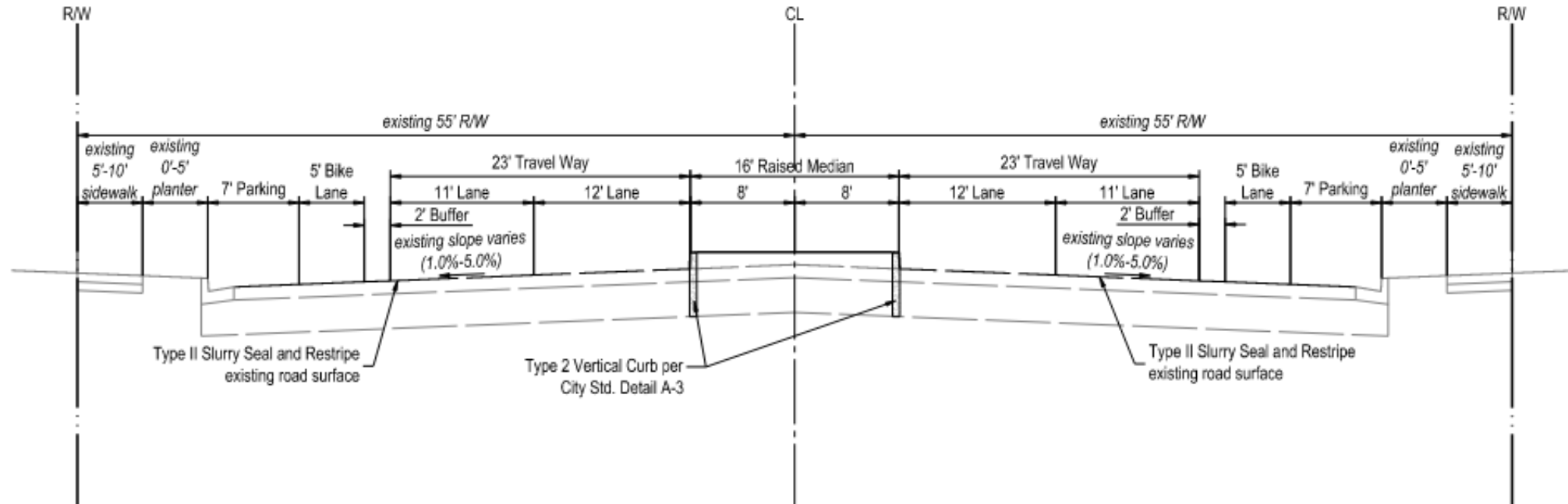
Project Overview

Project Scope of Work

- Raised median islands along Monterey Road
 - Reduce speed
 - Limit improper turning
- Seal Monterey Road Surface
- Restripe Monterey Road
 - Inclusion of buffered bike lanes along Monterey Road from Cochrane Road to East Middle Avenue.
 - Addition of green bike lane striping at intersections and conflict areas
 - Narrow lanes to reduce speeding
- Sidewalk Gap Closures

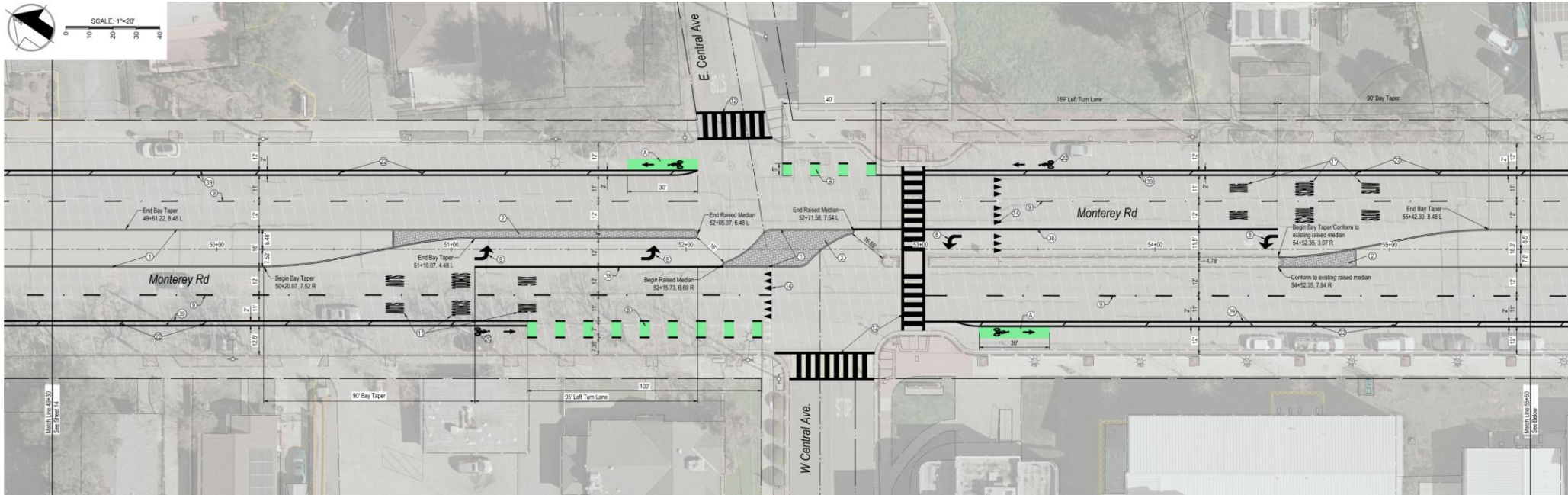
Monterey Road Proposed Striping

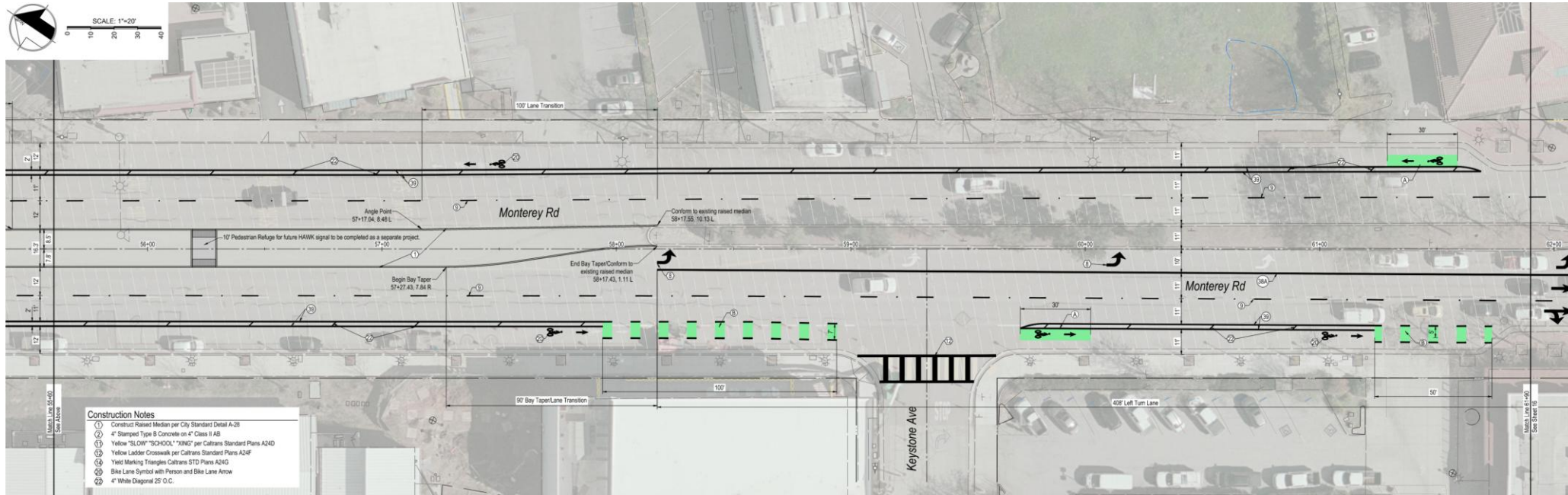

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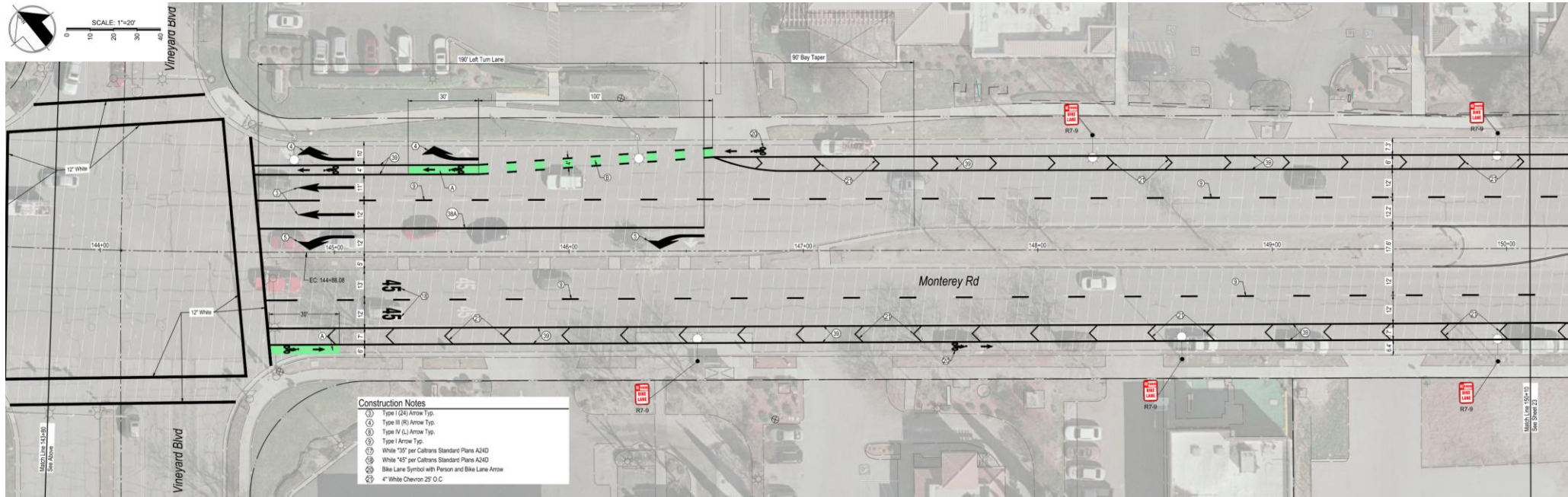

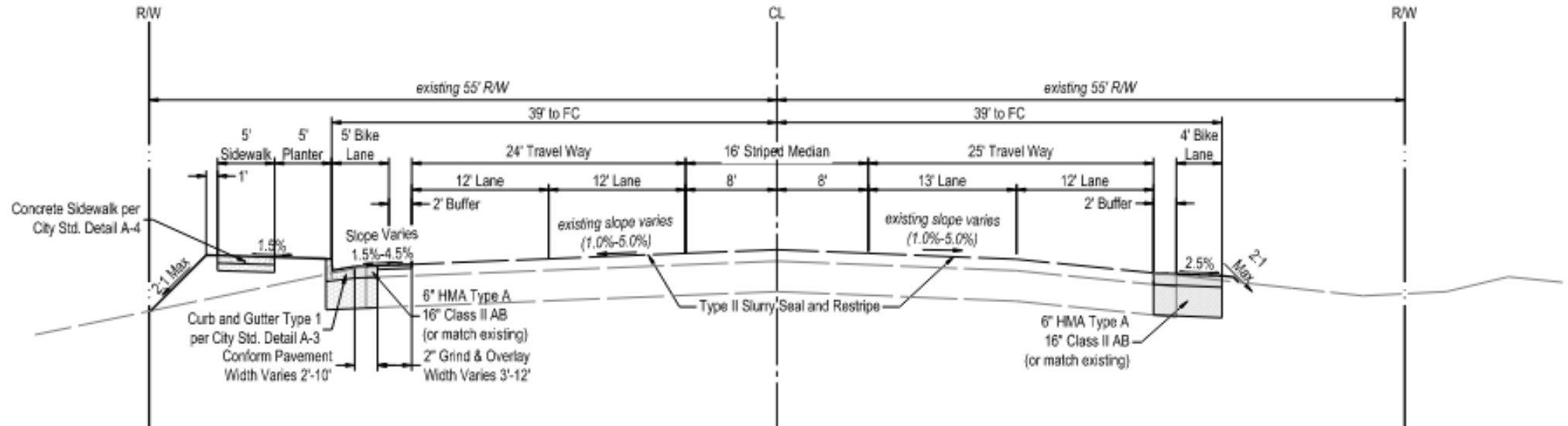
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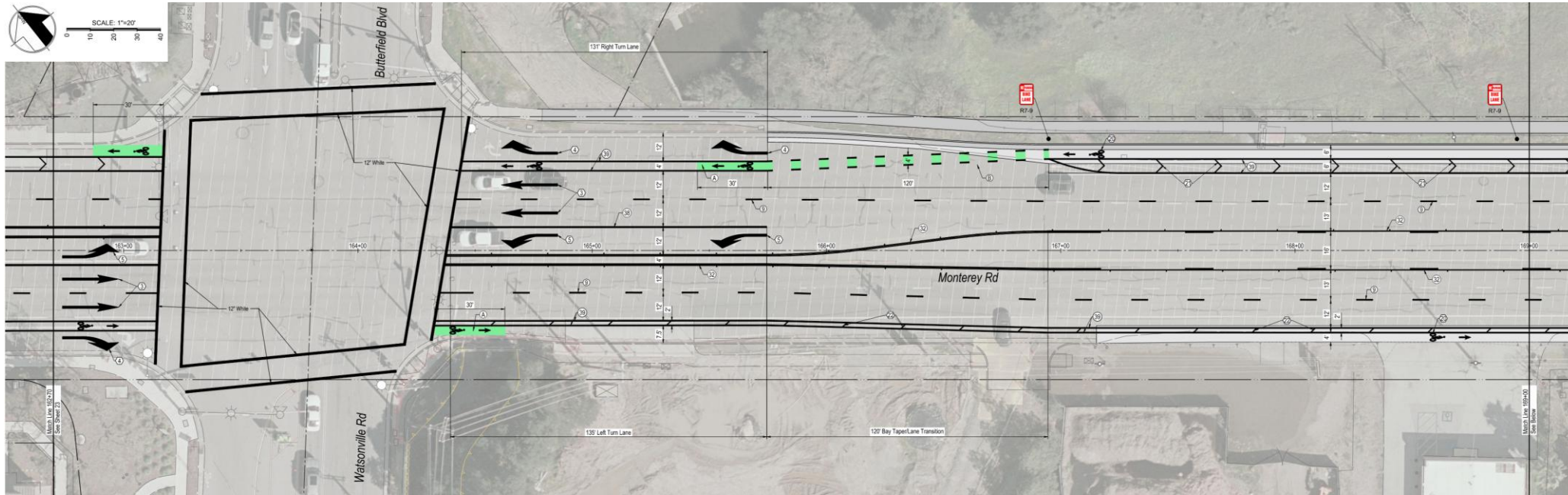
Monterey Road Cross Sections

New Northbound Detached Sidewalk and Southbound Buffered Bike Lane



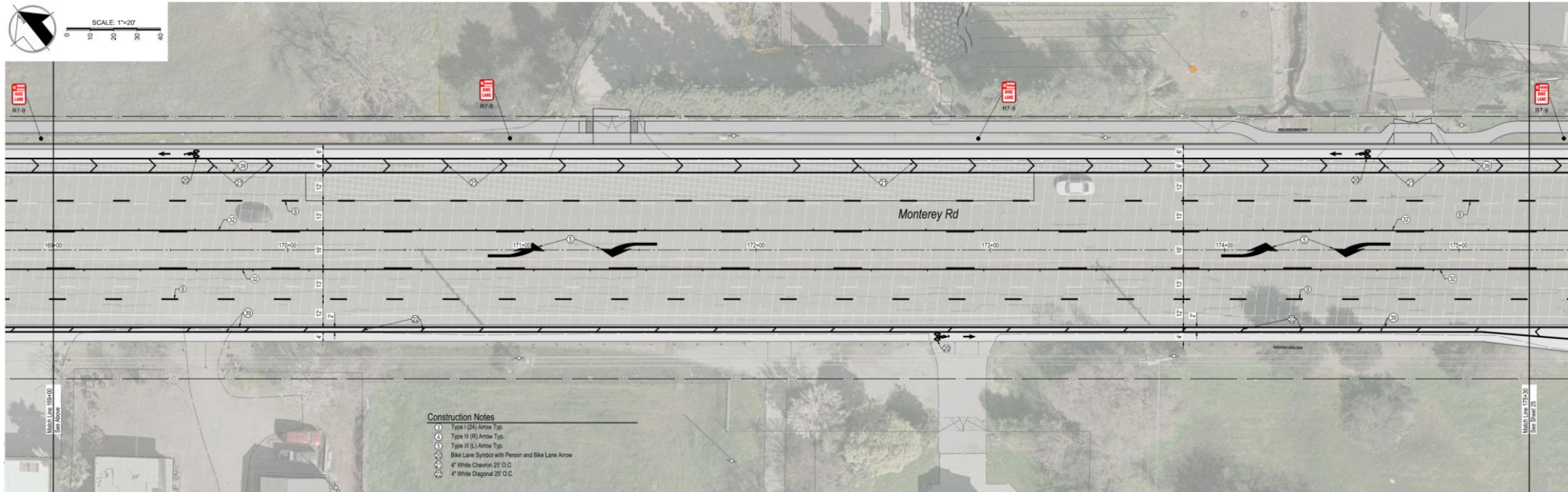
